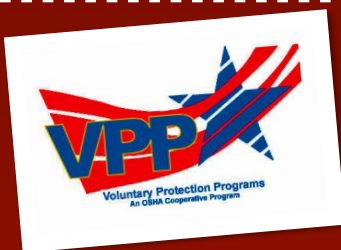
CONFINED SPACES & SILICA

Hands-On with Confined Spaces and OSHA's Proposed Silica Rule

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 10, 2015

Attendees will gain an understanding of OSHA's permit-required confined space standard, how to safely enter permitted spaces, and the role of the confined space rescue team. A hands-on tour of a mobile Confined Space Rescue trailer and Q&A session will be included.
